Island News Watch:

Coral Bay, once the largest town on St. John and the heart of the sugar plantations shipping industry, is undergoing new development. More and more people are moving across the mountain from Cruz Bay. They are wanting and needing more services. Starting with expanding the Love City Mini-Mart, there are many new businesses planned for the area around the current market. There will be space for vendor kiosks as well as space for sports activities such as a tennis court and a basketball court.

Alton Adams Jr., the architect for the project, and Genevieve Marsh Thomas, president of The G. E. Marsh Legacy Development and Holding Group Inc. informed the attendees of the St. John Coastal Zone Management Committee that they will develop the 4.9 acres of her family's property around the Mini-Mart and Domino gas station.

Concern was expressed that the infrastructure be in place before the development starts. Also, the property is in a flood zone and much of the land is environmentally or archaeologically sensitive but the developers believe that by working with the V.I. State Historic Preservation Office, the V. I. Public Works, CZM committee members and the V. I. Department of Planning and Natural Resources these issues will be addressed appropriately. Vice president of the Holding Group, Chanda Roberts, commented on the personal ties they have with this land unlike others that may come from off island to develope St. John.
